The Mississippi State University Industrial Training and Assessment Center (MSU-ITAC), is one of 37 university centers across the country, funded by the U.S. Department of Energy's Advanced Manufacturing Office, selected to provide free energy assessments to small and medium-sized manufacturing facilities and commercial buildings. The MSU-ITAC helps qualifying facilities in the state of Mississippi and surrounding areas save energy, improve productivity, and reduce waste by providing no-cost technical assessments conducted by a university-based team of engineering students and faculty.



What to expect from an assessment?

- Analysis of provided annual energy bills and expenditures
- Free one day energy assessment at your facility led by trained MSU students and staff members
- Energy and cost savings recommendations unique to your facility
- Report with recommended projects and their respective energy savings, implementation costs, and payback periods delivered within 60 days of assessment

Am I eligible?

FOR INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES

- Must be a U.S. Manufacturer
 - *SIC Code between 20-39 or*
 - *NAICS Code between 11, 21, 22, and 31-33*
- Within the State of Mississippi
- Annual Energy Bills:
 - *Greater than \$100,000*
 - *Less than \$2,500,000*
- Fewer than 500 employees at the plant site
- No in-house professional staff to perform assessment

FOR COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS

- Small-and-medium sized commercial building (non-manufacturing)
- Less than 100,000 ft²
